Information for passengers regarding the bomb disposal in Dresden on 23 October 2018

Restrictions on air traffic in connection with the planned defusing of an air bomb in Dresden on Tuesday, 23 October 2018, cannot be ruled out. This is due to the unfavourable location of the bomb site in the approach and departure routes of Dresden Airport.

Passengers who wish to fly next Tuesday or Wednesday are requested to check with their airline for any flight changes.

Continuously updated arrival and departure times can also be found at www.dresden-airport.de. In addition, any changes to flight operations will be communicated by Dresden Airport during the bomb disposal period via Twitter (@dresden_airport).

Thanks to the direct access road from the A4 motorway, 3000 parking spaces right next to the terminal building and the S-Bahn station, passengers from Saxony, Southern Brandenburg, Northern Bohemia and Lower Silesia can get to the airport easily and comfortably.

Short and barrier-free routes are characteristic of the unique Dresden Airport Terminal, a former aviation industry hangar. Arrivals and Departures as well as service areas can all be found under one roof. It is also home to Dresden's biggest travel centre, the Gate 14 airport shop (www.gate14.de) and a conference and events centre with a panoramic view of aircraft on the apron. The customer service was awarded the "Service Quality in Germany" level II certificate by the Saxon Tourist Board.
