## Early Christmas presents: Dresden Airport donates play equipment and vouchers to day nurseries

On Thursday morning, Dresden Airport presented two municipal day nurseries in the north of Dresden with play equipment and vouchers for guided tours of the airport. Götz Ahmelmann, chairman of the boards of Mitteldeutsche Flughafen AG and Flughafen Dresden GmbH, welcomed 30 children, nursery staff and Christian Wintrich, head of the Klotzsche/Pieschen district council office, to the terminal. The Theos Integrations-Kita day nursery in Klotzsche was given an indoor slide and the Piffikus day nursery in Hellerau was presented with a memory tree.

The play equipment is from the children's play corner on the Departures level in the public area. Following a revamp by toy manufacturers Sieper GmbH, the corner is scheduled to be re-opened in January 2019, equipped with SIKU toys and equipment.

**Flughafen Dresden GmbH** is a subsidiary of the Central German Airports Group with around 1.71 million passengers per year (2017).

Thanks to the direct access road from the A4 motorway, 3000 parking spaces right next to the terminal building and the S-Bahn station, passengers from Saxony, Southern Brandenburg, Northern Bohemia and Lower Silesia can get to the airport easily and comfortably.

Short and barrier-free routes are characteristic of the unique Dresden Airport Terminal, a former aviation industry hangar. Arrivals and Departures as well as service areas can all be found under one roof. It is also home to Dresden's biggest travel centre, the Gate 14 airport shop (<a href="www.gate14.de">www.gate14.de</a>) and a conference and events centre with a panoramic view of aircraft on the apron. The customer service was awarded the "Service Quality in Germany" level II certificate by the Saxon Tourist Board.
